India's Thermal Power Generation to Reduce by Half in Next Five Years

CEA has estimated that capacity utilisation of coal-based thermal power plants will fall to as low as 48 per cent by 2022 as additional non-thermal electricity generation capacities come on stream. CEA has predicted that by 2022 many plants may get partial or no schedule of generation at all – meaning many thermal

power plants may have to be kept idle for lack of demand. According to CEA, installed capacity from different fuel types at the end of 2021-22 in base case works out to be 523 gigawatt including 50 GW of coal based capacity addition currently under construction and likely to yield benefits during 2017-22.
