Indradhanu - The Thought **ENCOMPASSING SEVEN PILLARS** of Viraj Profiles CSR

A thoughtful step was taken this year to bring greater clarity and structure to the organisation's ongoing social efforts. With a clear focus on strengthening community engagement, the Indradhanu initiative was developed as a unified approach to social responsibility, bringing together diverse efforts under one meaningful direction.



Over the years, several initiatives have been undertaken across education, healthcare, the environment, and community welfare. The introduction of Indradhanu represents a purposeful effort to bring these initiatives into a more organised framework. It has provided direction to the work already in progress and enabled more effective planning and execution.

The initiative is built on seven key pillars: Education, Health & Hygiene, Environment, Skill Development, Women Empowerment, Rural Development, and Social Welfare & Disaster Relief. Each pillar reflects an area of importance where consistent efforts are being made and where further progress remains both necessary and achievable.

The expansion of outreach through Indradhanu has already begun. Vocational training, health check-ups, and related activities continue across multiple locations. Educational support will be strengthened through scholarships and improvements in school infrastructure. Health and hygiene initiatives will form part of broader wellness programmes, alongside a dedicated focus on women's well-being. Environmental efforts include tree plantation drives and the introduction of more environmentally sustainable practices within the identified regions.

In line with these efforts, a focused healthcare initiative was recently undertaken under Indradhanu. From 20th to 24th March 2026, a four-day Free Health Check-up Camp was organised in collaboration with Brahma Kumaris Global Hospital & Research Centre. The camp was conducted at Zilla Parishad School, Navapada; Gundle Gram Panchayat Office; Maan Dhodipada Bachat Gat Office on Main Road; Mahagaon Gram Panchayat Office; and near Aanganwadi School Kendra, Baripada.



The initiative witnessed active participation across all locations, reflecting both the need for and growing awareness of health and well-being. Basic health screenings, medical consultations, and eye examinations were provided. Qualified medical professionals ensured that everyone received timely attention, with emphasis placed not only on immediate care but also on preventive healthcare practices.

Skill development programmes, including training for youth and women in CNC machine operations, are being introduced to create pathways towards self-reliance, while rural development and social welfare initiatives continue to address local infrastructure needs and extend support during challenging circumstances.

We Virajians take collective pride in these efforts, recognising that meaningful progress is achieved through steady and sincere action. The Indradhanu initiative marks an important step towards bringing greater clarity, purpose, and direction to this shared commitment.

The programme began on a serene note, with a soulful rendition of the Rashtagaan by the visiting artists, setting a tone of respect and unity that resonated deeply with everyone present.

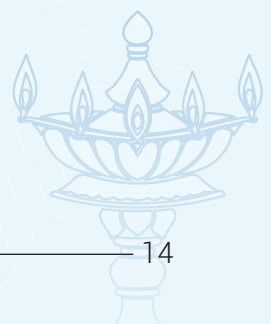
